6. EDUCATION

(i) Schools

The Board does not maintain any school.

(ii) Vocational Training

Vocational Training in courses of Tailoring and stitching is being imparted to needy women and school dropout children of the Cantonment.

7. ENVIRONMENT AND SANITATION

(i) General Sanitation

General sanitation in the cantonment remained satisfactory.

(ii) Ban on use polythene

Use of Polythene is banned in the cantonment.

(iii) Efforts made for improvement of Solid Waste management

Door to Door garbage collection is being carried out in the military and civil areas. Garbage is transported in covered vehicles.

(iv) Tree Plantation

120 saplings were planted during the year. Survival rate was about 60%.

8. PUBLIC HEALTH

(i) Hospital and Dispensaries

The Board maintains a Polyclinic. 9005 patients were treated during the year, Medicines were provided free of cost, Specialist medical services are being provided in Paediatrics, Gynaecology, and General Physician.

(ii) Kishori Clinic

Kishori clinic is being conducted bi-weekly by the Specialist in Gynaecology. Necessary guidance, treatment and free medicines are being provided.

(iii) Health care measures for Cantonment Board Employees & their dependents

Employees of Cantonment Board and their dependents are provided medical facilities from the dispensary. Biannual Health check up is conducted for Cantonment Board Employees.

Special measures taken for Senior Citizens

Health cards were provided to needy senior citizens and treatment and medicines were provided free of charge.

9. GENERAL ADMINISTRATION

(i) Status of Implementation of New Pension Scheme New Pension scheme has been implemented.

(ii) Public Grievances Redressal Mechanism

Complaint registers for registering complaints regarding electricity, water supply and sanitation are being maintained and monitored on day to day basis.

Audit of Accounts has been carried out upto Sept, 2019.

(iv) Any other initiative(s) in public interest

All Central and State Government welfare schemes for giving old age pension, widow pension, and pension for disabled are being implemented in the cantonment. Ration Cards were distributed among the residents.

Birth and Death registration is fully computerized. Software for calculation and disbursement of salary. Assessment of Property Tax and Grievances redressal are being developed.

(iv) Digitization of offices records

Phase II of digitization has been completed.

The Board maintains a market consisting 54 Shops and 27 Tin Shops, another market having 46 Shops under self-finance scheme and 9 shops in Pethiya Bazaar.
