Subject: शहर में कई कार पार्किंग योजनाएं/MULTILEVEL CAR PARKING SCHEMES IN CANTONMENT

MoD ID No.2(2)/2018-D(Q&C) दिनांक 05.11.2019 के संदर्भ में निर्देश दिया गया है कि सभी कैंटोनमेंट बोर्ड अपने क्षेत्रों में बहुस्तरीय कार पार्किंग की भूमि और अन्य आवश्यकताओं का पता लगाएंगे और बोर्ड द्वारा प्रस्ताव रखेंगे। उन्होंने यह भी सुझाव दिया है कि भूमि उपलब्धता, छावनी का स्थान, आबादी की सीमा, क्षेत्र की वित्तीय स्थिति और बोर्ड के लिए उपयुक्तता/बहुस्तरीय कार पार्किंग योजना की आवश्यकता, कार पार्किंग के आवंटित स्थान आदि जैसे निर्देशों का निर्देश डीजीडीई को दिया गया था। डीजीडीई पत्र क्रमांक सं0 133/एक्सपर्टसमिति/सी/डे/२०१९/ 67/बोल -२ दिनांक 09.११.२०१९ यह भी सलाह दी गई है कि कैंटोनमेंट बोर्ड, पुणे द्वारा कार्यान्वयन के तहत मल्टीलेवल कार पार्किंग परियोजना को मार्गदर्शन के उद्देश्य के लिए बोर्डों को यह भी सलाह दी गई है। छावनी बोर्डों को यह भी सलाह दी गई है कि वीकेंड पैप आधारित मॉडल पर विचार किया जा सकता है जिसके लिए सीईओ/कैंटोनमेंट बोर्ड, दिल्ली से मार्गदर्शन के लिए संपर्क किया जा सकता है। Reference to MoD ID No.2(2)/2018-D(Q&C) dated 05.11.2019 have instructed the all Cantonment Boards shall explore the land and other requirements of multilevel car parking in their areas and place the proposal before the Board. They have also suggested that parameters like land availability, location of Cantonment, population to be catered, financial position of the Board and suitability/requirement of Multilevel Car Parking scheme to the Board, proposed location of car parking etc. The instructions were communicated vide DGDE letter No.76/67/ExpertCommittee/C/DE/2018Vol-1 dated 07.11.2019. It has also further been advised that the Multilevel Car Parking project under implementation by Cantonment Board, Pune may be considered as a model by the Boards for the purpose of guidance. The Cantonment Boards were also advised that non-mechanised Ramp Based Model may be considered for which CEO/Cantonment Board, Delhi may be contacted for input.

यह क्षेत्र में यह बात सामने आई है कि क्षेत्र में मार्शल और सदर बाजार की मौजूदगी के कारण वार्ड 1, 3 और 4 के आसपास के इलाकों में भी ट्रैफिक और लोगों की भारी आवाजाही है, और देवनिया नाला से गुजरने वाली सड़क भी बाजार क्षेत्र के माध्यम से मुख्य संपर्क लिंक दानापुर- गांधी मैदान-बांकीपुर रोड है। इन कारकों के परिणामस्वरूप यह पाया गया है कि सड़कों को वाहनों और पैदल चलने वालों के साथ सबसे अधिक समय तक शोक किया जाता है। सिविल प्रशासन ने कई बार बैठकों में और अनौपचारिक प्लेटफार्मों में कैंटोनमेंट बोर्ड/सीईओ को सुझाव दिया है कि वे आधुनिक पार्किंग सुविधा बनाने या मौजूदा पार्किंगों को फिर से व्यवस्थित करने के द्वारा यातायात की भीड़ को कम करने के लिए आवश्यक कदम उठाएं। It is hereby brought to the notice of the Board that there is a huge movement of traffic and people in areas encompassing Ward 1,3 and 4, due to the presence of Marshall and Sadar Bazar in the area and also the road from Devania Nala passing through market area is the main connecting link Danapur- Gandhi Maidan-Bankipur Road. As a result of these factors it is found that the roads are most times choked up with vehicles and pedestrians. The civil administration has also many times in meetings and in informal platforms suggested/requested to Cantonment Board/CEO to take necessary steps to alleviate the traffic congestion by way of creating modern parking facility or re-organizing existing parkings.

क्षेत्र में कार्यालय ई-टेंडर के माध्यम से आउटसोर्सिंग करके टैक्सी-टेंपो जीप और बस मैक्सी पार्किंग शुल्क से प्रभावित उत्पन्न कर रहा है, जिसके लिए सर्वेक्षण संख्या 24 में एक क्षेत्र को मापने के लिए 0.587 एकड़ का जमीन कैंटोनमेंट हैकनी कैरिज और मोटर लॉरीज स्टैंड के लिए किया जा रहा है। यह भी उल्लेख किया जा सकता है कि रिकॉर्ड सर्वे नंबर 292 के अनुसार रिक्त भूमि जीएलआर 224 (यानी सड़क बीच में चल रही है) के समीप है और अक्सर स्नेक्स और टिन स्टॉल आदि के विक्रेताओं द्वारा अस्थायी रूप से अतिक्रमण किया जाता है। जीएलआर सर्वे सं0 292 में 0.914 एकड़ जमीन है और यह कैंटोनमेंट बोर्ड के प्रबंधन के अधीन एक खाली भूमि है, जो सर्वे सं0 290-1 के समीपवर्ती खाली क्षेत्र को 2331sqft. मापती है। कैंटोनमेंट बोर्ड के प्रबंधन के द्वारा खाली भूमि भी है।

Currently the office is generating revenue from Taxi-Tempo Jeep & Bus Maxi parking fee by measuring through e-tender for which space in Survey No.224 measuring an area 0.587 acres is being used for Cantonment Hackney Carriage and Motor Lorries Stand. It may also be mentioned that the vacant land as per GLR record Survey No.292 is opposite to Sy.No.224 (i.e. road is running in between) and is often encroached temporarily by vendors of snacks and Tin Cans etc. As per entry in GLR Sy.No.292 is 0.914 acres and is a vacant land under management of Cantonment Board adjacent vacant area of Sy.No.290-1 measuring 2331sqft. is a vacant land under the management of Cantonment Board.

सभी बोर्ड के प्रबंधन के तहत चैरिटेबल डिस्पेंसरी के उद्देश्यों के लिए सिविल अस्पताल मोड़ के कोने में स्थित प्लॉट नंबर 226 और 227 एक दूसरे से सटे हुए हैं, 227 0.564 एकड़ है। वर्तमान में यह निर्जन है और खंडहर पुरानी इमारत सर्वे सं० 227 खाली भूमि क्षेत्र 4150 वर्ग फीट है। Survey No.226 & 227 are adjacent to each other located in the corner of Civil Hospital More, 227 is 0.564 acres for the purposes of Charitable Dispensary under the management of Cantonment Board. Currently it deserted and old building lays in ruins. Sy.No.227 is vacant land area 4150sqft.


requested to invite consultancy/agency through e-tendering in respect to submit the feasibility report for establishing the car-parking places within Cantonment Area, Danapur Cantt.



(i) He requested to set up a submersible, a septic tank and urinals in Sulabh Mahalaya situated in Pethiya Bazar; (ii) 03 seater lady toilet, 03 seater jents toilet, 02 seater urinal, 02 seater jents urinal and one septic tank nearby town club, Danapur Cantt and 02 seater lady toilet, 02 seater jents toilet, 01 seater latrine for lady and jents separately with septic tank amidst Sabji Bazar, Danapur Cantt. Sh. Umesh Kumar, Vice-president in support of Smt. Razia Sultan, Elected Member, Ward No. 02 raised the problem of water pipeline. They requested to lay down water pipeline from (i) JhunJhun Wala park Boring to Main Barrack via Raushan Rajak house, (ii) From Raushan Rajak house to Dhobi Tola Boring, Main pipe via Baldev Gali(Street); (iii) From Late Babban ji house to infront of Rajak Boring main pipe. Sh. Indra Prasad, Elected Member, Ward No. 06 raised the drainage problem in Turhatoli, Danapur Cantt. Again Smt. Madhu Gupta, Elected Member, Ward No. 07 raised the road problem as to be constructed nearby Warnwal Saheb house and nearby member house. The problems raised by Sh. Umesh Kumar, Vice-president, Sh. Ranjit Kumar, Elected Member, Ward No. 01, Smt. Razia Sultan, Elected Member, Ward No.02, Sh. Indra Prasad, Elected Member, Ward No.06 and Smt. Madhu Gupta, Elected Member, Ward No.07 will be sort out as per availability of Fund of Danapur Cantonment Board.



Subject: ISSUE OF NOTICE UNDER SECTION 248 OF THE CANTONMENTS ACT, 2006 (41 OF 2006) FOR DEMOLITION OF UNAUTHORIZED CONSTRUCTION OF HOLDING No.12A, SURVEY No.202, QUARTERS No.12, M.No.03, W.No.05

Vide Circular Agenda No.09 dated 07.04.2020 the approval of the Board was sought as required U/s 248 of Cantonments Act, 2006 for issue of notice to demolish Unauthorized construction of H.No.12A, Survey No.202, Quarters No.12, M.No.03, W.No.05. However the approval of the Board i.e. majority approval was not received. Only approval from 06 members viz (1) Brig. A.K. Yadav, Dy.GOC (2) Col. Hemant Parmar (Adm. Comdt.), Nominated Member (3) Col. Tanuj Pandey, Col. 'Q' Nominated Member (4) Col. Ajay Kumar Singh, J.E. M.O., Ex-Officio Member (5) Shri Hemant Kumar Singh, GE, MES, Ex-Officio and (6) and Chief Executive Officer-cum- Secretary Member was obtained.

Therefore the same is put up before the board again for consideration. Detail is as follow:-

It is brought to the notice of the Board that the following unauthorized construction have been reported by the Senior Engineer vide this office report dated 07.04.2020.

Anandendra Nath, Advocate is handling cases in Hon'ble High Court, Patna and Sh. Raju Ranjan Prasad, a senior Advocate is handling cases in Tribunal Court, Dhanbad. 

Subject: PROVISION OF FUNDS FOR CANTT BOARD EMPLOYEES AS WELFARE MEASURE-GROUP INSURANCE SCHEME

Reference to Dte. letter No. 8688/Covid-19/Staff/20 dated 19th June, 2020 regarding provisions of funds for Cantt Board Employees as welfare measure-Group Insurance Scheme.

In the video conference chaired by DGDE, The issue of one time welfare measure for Covid-19 related activities was deliberated upon. It was decided that PDDE, WC, Nodal Principal Directorate, in consultation with other PDs DE shall finalize Group Insurance Scheme to provide protective cover to Cantonment Board Employees and relief in case of death to deceased family.

PDDE, WC, thereafter, consulted DGDE and other PDs DE and after interaction with member of public Sector Insurance Companies, proposed Group Insurance Scheme of LIC.

SALENT FEATURES OF THE SCHEME:

1. It will cover employees of the Board, both regular & contractual, involved in Covid-19 prevention/related activities.
2. Average Premium per beneficiary per annum comes in the range of Rs. 2500/- to 2700/- for 5.00 lakh sum assured (exact amount shall be fixed once number and details of each employees are finalized).
3. In case of unfortunate death because of any cause (includes disease, infection, accident etc.) the beneficiary family shall get Rs. 5.00 lakh relief.
4. LIC shall enter into agreement and furnish group policy one Cantt Board which shall be designated as Nodal Cantt Board. Here it will be Delhi Cantonment Board.

The total estimated expenditure will be between Rs. 80,000 to Rs. 01 lakh per year. The total expenditure on one time premium payment will be borne by the Board. This Office prepared a list of the employees which includes both permanent and contractual is being put up before the Board for recommendation which is to be sent to higher authorities as per directions.

Cantonment Board Office, Danapur Cantt has received applications from the contractor Sh. Rajendra Singh pertaining to the collection of Licence fee on entry of commercial vehicle in cantt area for the extension of the period of his contract for collection of Licence fee on entry of commercial vehicle in Danapur Cantt. area in lieu of the period of lockdown in view of the situation covid-19. Legal opinion on the same was sought from CBLA Sh. S.D. Sanjay, Sr. Advocate, Hon'ble High Court, Patna this office letter dtd. CBD/TS/Misc/CBLA/2020/777 dtd. 23.09.2020.

Sh. S.D. Sanjay, Sr. Advocate, Hon'ble High Court, Patna and Legal Advisor of Cantonment Board Office, Danapur perused the matter and provided legal opinion that

Whether the contract period in relation to a contract with its contractor for the purpose of collection of entry fees on Commercial Vehicles can be extended in view of the lockdown imposed by the Government of Bihar under the provisions of the Epidemic Disease Act, 1897 and by the Government of India with effect from 24.03.2020 in exercise of powers under the Disaster Management Act, 2005 prohibiting movement of public and also the plying of commercial vehicles on the road in the state of Bihar including Danapur Cantonment area, so as to enable the contractor to work for the extended period and collect the commercial vehicle entry fee. It appears that the contractor was deprived of his right to collect the same during the period of lockdown. It appears that the Cantonment Board Office, Danapur had floated tender for collection of entry fee from commercial vehicles for the period 01.09.2019 to 30.09.2020. It was found that after the process of tender, one Shree Rajendra Singh was allotted the contract for purpose of collection of entry fee on the commercial vehicles plying in the area of the Cantonment Board.

In view of the outbreak of COVID-19 and in order to check the spread of the novel virus, the Government of Bihar in exercise of powers under Section 3 of the Epidemic Disease Act, 1897 imposed complete lockdown in the state of Bihar which was further followed by the notifications issued by the Government of India from 25th of March, 2020 to 31st of May, 2020. In the State of Bihar, in view of the prevailing situations in the Government of Bihar, complete lockdown was imposed during the period of 15th of July to 31st of July 2020. Therefore, due to different notifications of the Government of Bihar and Government of India, complete lockdown and prohibition on plying of vehicles including commercial vehicles on the roads and in the area of the Board.

It was found that the revenue of the contractor from collecting entry fees from outside to within the Cantonment Board area was completely dependent upon the plying of commercial vehicles in the area and due to imposition of lockdown in the nation, the plying of such vehicles was completely prohibited and thereby, the contractor was prohibited by the statutory orders of the government from receiving revenue which he was entitled under the Contract to receive with regard to the contract for collection of entry fees. Thus, the contractor was prevented by the statutory order of the government to collect entry fees during the period of lockdown because the vehicles were prohibited from plying on the road and public at large were also prohibited from movement with reference to those which were permitted by the authorities. Thus, the collection of entry fees was

...due to the reasons beyond the control of the contractor during the period of lockdown. It can also be said to be a situation of force majeure attracting the provision under the Contract Act in relation to force majeure.

The Government of India has also with respect to contracts has extended the contract period in such cases. In the present case the period of contract was for one year and keeping in mind that for one year the contractor had estimated his revenue collection for a period of 12 months based on that he had submitted his bid.

Further due to the statutory lockdown for about 3 months, he was prevented from collecting the fees and therefore, it will be just and proper in terms of the Contract Act to extend his contract by three months so that he may not have any claim against the Board.




Sh. Nanjay, Sr. Advocate, Hon'ble High Court, Patna and Legal Advisor of Cantonment Board Office, Danapur perused the matter and provided legal opinion that

Legal opinion has been sought from me on the issue as to whether the contract period in relation to the contract with its contractor for collection of parking fees on parking of Tempo and Taxi etc. in the Cantonment Board area at the designated place of parking can be extended in view of the lockdown imposed by the Government of Bihar under the provisions of the Epidemic Disease Act, 1897 from 23.03.2020 and by the Government of India with effect from 24.03.2020 in exercise of power under the Disaster Management Act, 2005 prohibiting movement of public and commercial vehicles on the road in the state of Bihar including Danapur Cantonment Board area as to enable the contractor to work for the extended period and collect the Tempo, Taxi & Jeep Parking Fees as the contractor was deprived of his right to collect the same during the period of lockdown.

It appears that the Cantonment Board Office, Danapur had floated tender for collection of Parking Fees on Tempo, Taxi & Jeep for the period 01.11.2019 to 31.10.2020. It appears that in the process of tender, one Shree Nazir Prasad was allotted the contract for the purpose of collecting Parking Fee of Tempo, Taxi & Jeep parked in the area of the Cantonment Board.

Due to outbreak of COVID-19 and in order to check the spread of the novel virus, the Government of Bihar in exercise of powers under the provisions of the Epidemic Disease Act, 1897 imposed complete lockdown in the state of Bihar from 23.03.2020 which was further followed by the notifications of lockdown published by the Government of India from 24th of March, 2020 to 31st of May, 2020. In the State of Bihar, in view of the prevailing situations in the Government of Bihar, further imposed complete lockdown during the period of 15th day of July, 2020 to 31st day of July, 2020. Therefore, due to different notifications of the Government of Bihar and Government of India, there existed complete lockdown and prohibition on plying of commercial vehicles including commercial vehicles on the roads and in the area of the Board.

It appears that the revenue of the contractors from collecting Parking Fees on Tempo, Taxi & Jeep were completely dependent upon the parking and plying of such vehicles in the Board area. 

Therefore, due to different notifications of the Government of Bihar and the Government of India, there existed complete lockdown and prohibition on plying of vehicles including commercial vehicles on the roads and in the area of the Board as a result of which no bus or maxis being public vehicle could be parked.

It appears that the revenue of the contractors from collecting parking fees for Buses and Maxis in the Cantonment Board Area is completely dependent upon the plying of commercial vehicles in the Board area and due to the complete lockdown in the nation, the plying of such vehicles was completely prohibited and as a result, the contractor was prohibited by the statutory orders of the State from receiving revenue. Thus, they were entitled under the Contract to receive with regard to the contract for collection of parking fees. Thus, the contractor was prevented by the statutory order of the government to collect

... during the period of lockdown because the vehicles were prohibited from plying on ... and public at large were also prohibited from movement with exception to those which ... permitted by the authorities. Thus, the contractor was prevented from collection of parking ... due to the reasons beyond the control of the contractor during the period of lockdown. It ... can be said to be a situation of force majeure attracting the provision under the Contract Act ... to force majeure.

Government of India has also with respect to contracts has extended the contract period in ... cases. In the present case the period of contract was for one year and keeping in mind that ... of one year the contractor had estimated his revenue collection for a period of 12 months ... based on that he had submitted his bid. However due to the statutory lockdown for about 3 ... he was prevented from collecting parking charges on buses and maxis and therefore, it ... is just and proper in terms of the Contract Act to extend his period by three months so that ... not have any claim against the Board.

... fore, in view of the aforesaid legal and factual position, I am of the considered view that ... contract period of the contractor which was expiring on 30.09.2020 can be extended by 3 ... I opine accordingly."

... matter along with all the relevant documents/papers are placed before the Board for ... eration and approval of the same.

RESOLUTION: The Board Considered and approved to extend the contract for parking rights ... collection of bus, maxi parking fee in bus stand Danapur Cantt. to the Contractor Shri Lailesh ... for a period of three months w.e.f. 01.10.2020 to 31.01.2021.
