

REGARDING MAINTENANCE OF CANTONMENT JHUNJHUNWALA PARK

It is brought to the notice of the Board that Sh. Bimal Kishore Jhunjhunwala has conveyed his interest for maintenance the Jhunjhunwala park, falling under the jurisdiction of the Cantonment Board, Danapur, in Ward No. 02. He has submitted an application dated 26.12.2025 for the maintenance and upkeep of *Jhunjhunwala Park*. The objective of the proposal is to ensure systematic and regular cleaning of the park, proper horticulture maintenance, maintenance of existing park infrastructure, and enhancement of public amenities for the benefit of residents.

A file containing the relevant documents/papers are placed before the Board for perusal and approval of the same.



PROCUREMENT OF HEMATOLOGY ANALYZER, RAPID TEST KIT AND BIOCHEMISTRY TEST KIT FOR THE DISPENSARY OF CANTONMENT BOARD, DANAPUR

It is brought to the notice of the Board that a dispensary is functioning under the management of the Cantonment Board, Danapur Cantt, wherein approximately 500 patients are attended every month. Thus, more than 6,000 patients annually are availing medical facilities such as Gynaecology, General Physician consultation, Dental care, Ayurveda, and Homeopathy as provided by the Cantonment Board through the said dispensary.

A significant number of patients attending the dispensary require blood investigations as part of their diagnosis and treatment. In view of this requirement and in the larger public interest, it is proposed that the Cantonment Board, Danapur, may provide in-house blood testing facilities to ensure timely and efficient medical support to the beneficiaries. To operationalize this facility, it is essential to procure the requisite instruments, equipment, and test kits through the Government e-Marketplace (GeM) portal, strictly in accordance with prevailing government procurement norms and procedures.

The estimated expenditure for establishing the blood testing facility is approximately Rs. 5,00,000/- (Rupees Five Lakhs only). Necessary budget provision for the same exists under BE 2025-26.

A file containing all relevant documents and papers is placed before the Board for its perusal and for seeking approval to proceed further in the matter.


RESOLUTION: The Board discussed the matter in detail and, after due deliberation, decided to follow the prescribed procedure to ensure the quality and proper functioning of the testing machine, tubes, and related certifications. The Board further directed that the deployed personnel must be adequately trained and possess sufficient knowledge of blood test diagnostics to ensure proper care and issuance of authentic reports. The Board also instructed that the one-year AMC cost and disposal of waste under Bio-Medical Waste Management norms be duly ensured. Finally, it was decided to place the matter before the Board in the next meeting.




